Artists' RFQ packet should include the following

Letter of interest of no more than one page in length that explains the artist's interest in the project and describing artists qualifications.

Current résumé. If submitting as a team, a current resume should be submitted for each team member.

RFQ deadline: April 15, 2021

Images of previous work (max 8). Digital images are preferred and should be .jpg or .png format 300 dpi minimum. Does not have to be a mural but should display ability for such a work.

Image list which must include: artist's name, title, date, medium, size, and if a commissioned project, location, and the commission budget (if applicable).

References. Submit at least two professional references who have intimate knowledge of the artist's work and working methods. List must include name, title, company/organization, email address, and phone number.

Contact details. Include a phone number, address, and/or email address where you can be reached.

Optional. The artist may include up to three selections of support materials such as reviews, news articles, and other related information.

The Selection/Payment Process:

The Artist Selection Committee will review all artist submissions and select up to two artists to submit concept ideas for review.

The two selected artists will then be invited for a site visit and asked to provide at least two design concepts, each artist will be paid \$300 for the concept work.

The committee will select the design concept are artist Finalist.

The Finalist will develop a detailed proposal for the site that includes materials list, size, maintenance guidelines, and final budget. The Finalist will present the proposal to the Committee for final review and approval.

Once final contract is signed, payment for the art rights, and 1/3 of the labor will be paid. Final payment will be made upon completion. Materials included in the approved budget will be paid for by Main Street Beatrice.
